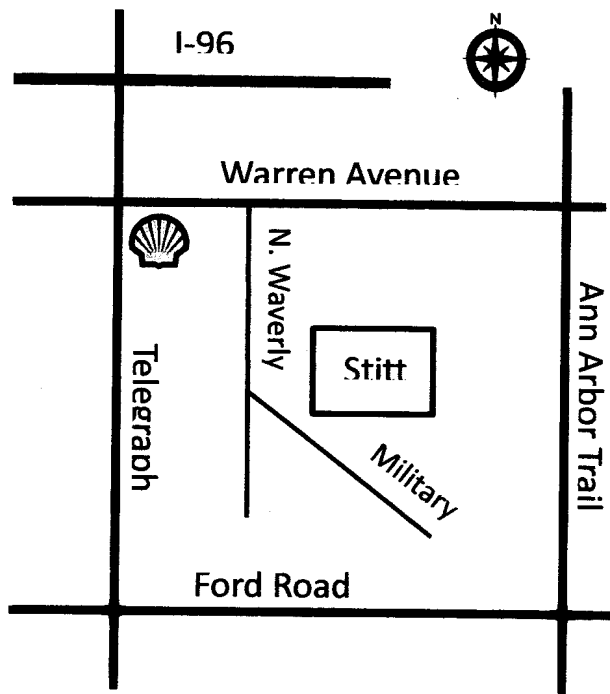

CANADA NIGHT – MINI-CHORUS CONTEST – RULES

1. A mini-chorus may consist of not less than 10 nor more than 16 men plus a director, all from the same chapter
2. More than one mini-chorus may represent a chapter; however, no individual may sing in more than one mini-chorus from his chapter except to fill out a final mini-chorus to 10 members.
3. Dual members may participate for any chapters with whom they hold a membership.
4. Each mini-chorus will perform two songs and will be scored by a single panel of judges using the standard judging categories of Music, Presentation and Singing. Although uniforms are not required for competition, the Presentation judge may take appearance of the mini-chorus into consideration in his scoring.
5. each judge will be assigned a category – music, presentation or singing – and will score each mini-chorus from 0 to 100 points. If a judge is a participant in a mini-chorus, a substitute judge will replace him for that performance only.
6. Late entries will be allowed.
7. The Contest Administrator will record the scoring of each judge and record the total for each mini-chorus. At the conclusion of the contest, with any necessary assistance from the judges, he will total all scores and determine the third place, second place and winning mini-chorus.
8. Only the top three finishers will be announced. Detroit-Oakland's president will present the trophy, The Old Oakland Bucket, to the winners.
9. The winning mini-chorus will sing one acceptance song.
